Lesson 1

Lesson Objectives

Vocabulary: cheetah; Verbs: run, climb, swim, jump, walk

Grammar: It can

Materials: flashcard of cheetah to introduce new action verbs: run, climb, swim, jump, walk, fly



Warmer

- With books closed, show the children the flashcard of the cheetah. Ask them what animal they think it is and what colour it is. Ask students to name other big cats they know. Write them up on the board.
- Finally, write the word cheetah on the board and have the children repeat. Then ask the children to open their books and look at the photo of the cheetah.

Listen, point and say.

- Ask students to open their books and study the photo of the cheetah carefully. Ask questions about the cheetah – What colour is it? Where does it live? and give some background information about cheetahs.
- Then ask students to look at activity 1. Play the CD and have children listen. Play the CD again, and ask students to point to the characters/animals and repeat the words.



Fast facts about cheetahs


- the cheetah is the fastest land animal (it can run up to 113k.p.h)
- cheetahs can see very well, but it is hard to see them because there spots
- they live in open grassland and bushy areas in East and SE Africa, and the Middle East.
- Cheetahs are endangered there are about 7,000 10,000
- Cheetahs don't roar they purr!

2 Listen and read.

- Write the verbs run, climb, swim, jump, and walk on the board. Ask the children to stand up and mime each one in turn and repeat the word.
- Ask them which actions they think a cheetah can do. Play the CD and have them listen and read along.
- Ask the children again if a cheetah can run, climb etc. Choose individual children to come out to the board and write a tick or a cross next to each verb. Then do the same for Freddy.



- Divide your class into two groups and choral drill the questions and answers. E.g. Have the first group ask Can it run? and the second group reply Yes, it can.
- Choose five children to come out to the front of the class with their books. Allocate roles and ask the children to act out the dialogue. Repeat with other groups.
- Ask the children to look at the Find Me feature and see if they can identify the panda. Encourage them to look through Unit 6 to try and find the picture of the panda. Ask students to raise their hand when they have found it and check together as a class. Ask the children what they think a panda can do. **Answer:** The panda is on page XX



Lesson 2

Lesson Objectives



Vocabulary: fish, parrot, camel, monkey, kangaroo: Verbs: swim, fly, walk, run, climb, jump

Grammar: can

Materials: animal flashcards to introduce animal vocabulary: fish, parrot, camel, monkey, kangaroo, cheetah; Piece of paper for each child



Warmer

- Introduce the names of the animals using the animal flashcards. Show the children the flashcards in turn and elicit any words they know. Include the cheetah flashcard.
- Write the names of the animals across the board and have the children repeat. Then hand out flashcards and choose individual children to come to the front and stick the correct flashcard next to the name of the animal.

Listen and point, then say.

 Ask students to open their books and look at the animal photos. Play the CD and have them point to the correct photo. Then play the CD again for students to repeat the words.

2 Listen and circle.

- Practise the action verbs learned in the previous lesson by calling out a verb and asking the children to mime.
- Ask the children to work in pairs and look at the sentences in activity 2 and try to circle the correct answer. Then ask them to listen and check their answers. **Answers:** 2 run, 3 fly, 4 walk 5 climb 6 jump

Cooler

- Play a True/False game with the children. Give each child a piece of paper (or have them write at the back of their notebooks) and ask them to write True on one side and false on the other.
- Call out sentences about animals e.g. A fish can jump, while the children hold up their True or False answer.

Teaching tip

Encourage more able children make up other sentences about animals while other children say if they are true or false.

Lesson 3

Lesson Objectives



Vocabulary: fish, parrot, camel, monkey, kangaroo, cheetah;

Verbs: swim, fly, walk, run, climb, jump

Grammar: can/ can't

Materials: animal flashcards from lesson 2 to introduce animal abilities



Warmer

- Revise the names of the animals using the animal flashcards. Play a simple guessing game. Ask the students to guess each card e.g. Is it a cheetah? Is it a camel? Hand out the flashcard to the child that guesses correctly.
- Introduce can't by asking questions about each flashcard e.g. Can a camel fly? Write can't on the board. Do lots of oral practice with can and can't. Avoid short answers at this stage.

Listen and point, then say.

- Play the CD and ask students to listen, point to the words and repeat
- Ask the students to look at the Notice feature. Write the words can't and cannot on the board and explain the short and long forms. Drill the words and emphasise the different vowel sounds....

- Write the example on the board and point to the cross. Ask a child to come to the board and circle the word can't.
- Then ask the students to work individually to read the sentences and circle the correct word. Check answers with the whole class. Answers: 2 can't 3 can 4 can 5 can 6 can't



Teachina tip

• Encourage fast finishers to make up an extra question following the example in activity 2. Give out strips of paper and ask them to write a question for the class. When all the students have finished collect any strips of paper and read them out for the class to answer..

- Ask the children to work in pairs and tell their friend what they can and can't do. Point to the example pictures in the SB.
